

PARKING AT COLLINGWOOD TOWN HALL



Our venue is designed for your convenience. It is easily accessible by car, train, and bus, with a map of the surroundings provided for your reference. We've made sure that getting to the Collingwood Town Hall is as easy as possible for you.

The Collingwood Town Hall has a car park with approximately 35 spaces, located at the Collingwood Library/Train Station. Please note that parking is restricted to 4 hours before 5:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, and is unrestricted after 5:30 p.m. and on weekends.

There is street parking along Hoddle St (approximately 25 spaces), Stanton St (approximately 30 slots), and Park St (approximately 15 spaces). Most of these spaces are 4 hours before 5:30 p.m. and unrestricted after 5:30 p.m. and at weekends, but please abide by individual parking signs. There is also parking across the road from the Hall on the other side of Hoddle St and Hood St.

A large gravel car park at the end of Eddy Court can be used for functions on Saturday and Sunday only. Parking in this area Monday through Friday without a council sticker may result in a fine. There are approximately 35-40 spaces. Please be careful if parking in Eddy Court- we share this area with Victoria Police and the Senior Citizens Centre so that we can follow the signs. There are limited accessible parking spaces in this area.

The Epping/Hurstbridge line services Collingwood Town Hall. Not all trains stop here, so we suggest you check before you board.

Several bus lines run along Hoddle St., including 313 & 315 from Collins St., 302-3 from Queen St. and the **Nightrider bus 961** from Swanston St.
